The Royal Albert Hall's newly refurbished restaurant, the Cafe Consort, is graced with a bespoke lighting sculpture manufactured and installed by S3i - Stainless Steel Solutions.

The new Cafe Consort rooms have been restored to their original proportions, with clearer spaces, velvet paneled inner walls and cut glass mirrors in the windows to maximise light.

The piece, known as The Helix, occupies the space traditionally reserved for a chandelier. Each Helix is 25m in length, made in stainless steel with 148 discs of lightly etched glass, and spiral through the restaurants like two elongated strands of illuminated DNA.

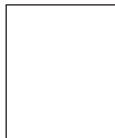
